## *Tasting Notes* \_\_\_\_\_

Red Schooner is a “red wine of the world,” the creation of two great winemaking cultures. The grapes are grown in the Andes Mountains in Mendoza, Argentina, famed for its high altitude and intense sunlight, which are ideal for a Malbec. The grapes are then shipped chilled to California, where they are produced into wine at Caymus Vineyards.

Because the creation of Red Schooner is unique, it falls outside typical labeling rules – instead of a vintage date, varietal name or appellation, this wine is known simply by the voyage from which it traveled. Voyage 9 refers to the 2019 vintage.

*This wine is big and robust, wrapped in velvety softness. It features smooth tannins and a concentrated flavor, which make it ideally suited for the savory and smokey flavors of the cheddar grits and fried coconut.*
